What is the Overall Status of Countries having Industry Level Prices Calculated and Industry Level Turnover Collected?





60% or more of responding countries









- Beginning with VG 2009, we have been asking 2 yes, no, questions for each industry
- We have Tracked Progress of All (56) Industries Covered by the Voorburg Group Progress Reports Since 2006
- Since VG 2009 We have been Assessing in Terms of:
  - Additional countries actually having (price/turnover) data (reflecting their initial response to coverage-and coverage "soon"-in the first year measured and their response for the current year)



<u>Task Force 1:</u> Continue VG Task Force to obtain and disseminate country report information on the industry/industry groups to be covered next year

#### By December 2011:

 Develop an e-mail questionnaire, based on the VG 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, and 2011 progress report worksheet questionnaires, to collect PPI and turnover activity for the industry/industry groups to be covered at VG 2012

#### By February 2012:

Implement the survey via e-mail (with a due date of June 30, 2012)

#### By July 2012:

- Close out the survey

- We are on track to complete the initial sweep of industry / industry group priorities by 2012.
- What's next for the Voorburg Group?
  - Teleconference of the Voorburg Bureau held on August 10, 2011 and subsequent communication with the United Nations Statistical Division (UNSD) on August 23, 2011.
  - There is still a need for the VG to continue work on turnover, prices, and classification for the services area of the economy because the large scope of services and continuously changing landscape need to be addressed.
  - Revisit the mandate to expand beyond industry / industry group subject area reviews and address the larger Cross-Cutting Issues (manufacturing services, repair services, outsourcing, quality adjustment) that impact the quality of turnover, prices, and classification for service industries and products.



### Future Agenda (continued)

- What's next for the Voorburg Group? (continued)
  - The VG should continue to expand interaction with the Eurostat / OECD taskforce working on the SPPI Manual and attempt to align the needs of that group with the VG work plan.
  - The VG should more formally record and submit observations on services industries and products to the United Nations Statistical Division (UNSD) as part of the Expert Group on International Economic and Social Classification five year review plan for ISIC and the CPC. (This begins with our Revisited Industry/Industry Group Mini-presentations beginning in 2013.)
  - After the VG 2012 meeting, the VG Bureau should submit a "Report of the Voorburg Group on Services Statistics" for inclusion on the agenda for the February 2013 meeting of the United Nations Statistical Commission (UNSC).
    - In that report we plan to cite the major accomplishments of having met the objectives of the current work plan and also include a description of the mandate going forward which would include a greater focus on the Cross-Cutting Issues and more formal interactions with the two groups described above.

<u>Task Force 3:</u> The Voorburg Bureau will propose selected industry/industry groups for which to do Revisited Industry/Industry Group Mini-presentations beginning in 2013

#### By December 2011:

 Determine criteria and priorities for selected the revisited industry/industry groups, and develop a preliminary set of groups to propose to the Voorburg Group members

#### By February 2012:


 Obtain feedback from the Voorburg Group on the preliminary set of revisited industry/industry groups
