




Importance of services

Services are over 70% of OECD GVA and growing



But international trade in services is small ... but growing!



And 'trade' through direct investment (FATS) is ...growing faster



Considerable progress in services statistics over 20 years

- Voorburg group
- General Frameworks and Manuals
 - SNA93, BPM5, International trade in services
- Classifications ISIC rev 3, CPC
- Manuals on Price and volumes
 - EU Price and volumes handbook
 - PPI manual (IMF)
- Eurostat Regulations on registers, SBS, national accounts, NACE
- Implementation of guidelines has yielded much more data which are more comparable
- But much much more to do!



Better coordination

ABS reported to UNSC, March 2003

- Noted considerable progress over 20 years
- Many groups working on aspects of services statistics
- Identified coordination issues
 - To identify gaps and duplication
 - Communicate conceptual outputs to those who need

UNSC asked OECD to assist it in coordinating work on services statistics



OECD services coordination activities

- Light focused approach
- Try to get an overall picture
- Based on discussion and cooperation
- Take account of other major coordination exercises on SNA, BPM, ISIC, CPC revisions plus UNECE exercise
- Consider user needs
- Raise awareness of services issues, activities of groups, methodological outputs
 - OECD web pages
 - Links to methodological outputs; activities; data
- Consult within OECD, with Expert Groups, International Organisations, Country experts
- Matrix of issues, activities, groups, contacts, links
- Progress report and strategy proposals to UNSC 2005

- ICT and content and other services products
- Quality and quality change
- Extend satellite accounting to more sectors
- Turnover by product
- Interaction between services and rest of economy
- Measuring output of retail, wholesale and margin industries
- Others????

- Resources?



Draft OECD proposals

- Engage more developing countries in services agenda enhance interagency cooperation - there is a role for us all (UNSD to lead?)
- International organisations to review their own work/data collection and dissemination to reflect better services role in modern economy (all)
- Voorburg Group is a useful forum, network and catalyst for services statistics developments, has done valuable work on PPIs,
 - needs to improve focus, plan outputs with timetable
- Webpages with links need more attention
- Need to improve infrastructure and (comparability of) services statistics generally
- Spell out what more work on Service Producer
 Prices/Volumes/Products/Structural Business Statistics/ICT/Trade
- Monitor and improve data quality and comparability
- Address Balance, Resource Costs and Respondent burden issues
